

ELYOCELL SERIES

Elyocell is the generic name of a broad range of liquid organic pigments; they generally have relatively low dyeing values. When they are used in big quantities in deep shades, they act as fillers, thus the opacity and the paper's weight are increased and the sheet is weakened.

The synthetic pigments **Elyocell** are the most important type used for internal paper dyeing or for inks and color of paper coatings. Their particle size and dispersion grade is often so fine that a dilute suspension appear to be soluble in water.
